



Drs. Raymond and Ann Pearson Master Teacher Award

This annual award recognizes an exceptional Lincoln Land Community College faculty member for his or her professional contributions to student learning at LLCC. Longtime Springfield physicians, Drs. Raymond and Ann Pearson made this award possible through a generous contribution to the LLCC Foundation.

Guidelines

- Only current, full-time, tenured Lincoln Land Community College faculty members are eligible for nomination. Nominees must not have been subject to discipline under Section 10.1b – 10.1e of the faculty collective bargaining agreement. All nominations are verified for eligibility by LLCC Human Resources.
- Students, alumni, faculty members, retirees and colleagues are eligible to submit a nomination. A faculty member may not nominate him or herself.
- Nominations may only be submitted via the LLCC Foundation web site at www.LLCCFoundation.org. **Late nominations will not be accepted.**
- Faculty members may be nominated numerous times; however, a faculty member may receive the award one time only. [Click here](#) for a list of past recipients.
- If a nominee elects to continue through the Master Teacher process, he or she will be required to complete a written packet, including an essay and letters of recommendation, to be reviewed by a selection committee. The selection committee will include LLCC Foundation board members and an LLCC student representative.
- Primary consideration will be given to a professor who has had a significant impact on LLCC students because of his/her commitment to students and learning.
- The selected Master Teacher will receive a \$2,500 award to be used to enhance teaching/learning.
- Equipment and other purchases become the property of the college. The Foundation is not responsible for upgrades or replacement of equipment.
- All materials submitted are the property of LLCC and may be used for promotional purposes.
